The selection process will be by written application and panel interview.

The written application will include:

- A 300 to 500 word autobiographical essay indicating their special interests, achievements as outlined in the criteria and the contribution they would make to the life of the College.
- Two reference letters supporting the candidate’s chosen activities. Current Pymble students do not require a reference. Current students are welcome to provide a reference from an external coach/adult.
- The applicant’s last TWO semesters’ school reports and recent NAPLAN test results.

The panel interview will include members of the Scholarship Selection Committee and members of staff with responsibility for the candidate’s nominated disciplines.

Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the College. The results of the Academic scholarship test are not shared and feedback for unsuccessful applications will not be given.

DECLARATION

I understand that if I am selected as one of the recipients of a Performance Scholarship – Sport at Pymble Ladies’ College, the scholarship is conditional on the following;

- 1 A scholarship holder will endeavour to maintain an appropriate level of academic achievement.
- 2 In all areas of school life, a scholarship holder must be a positive role model and demonstrate substantial commitment to *Pymble* sport and fully support the ethos and values of the College.
- 3 A scholarship holder will be expected to represent the College in her main sport and any other sports she is selected in.
- 4 A scholarship holder will have access to a number of high quality coaches at the school and will be expected to attend associated training sessions, camps and College sporting events. When a scholarship holder is selected to represent the College, she must honour her commitment or discuss a potential conflict with the Director of Sport. Leave will be granted at the discretion of the Director of Sport.
- 5 A scholarship holder’s performance will be reviewed annually in terms of her participation in College sport and her all round performance in both sport and academic studies.
